

IWC Replica Watch Comparison

IWC replica watch quality ranges the full gamut from poor to exceptionally accurate. Recently some very high quality IWC replica watches have come onto the market, making it advisable to seek professional help when purchasing one of these watches.

The easiest way to spot a replica IWC is from the general build quality. IWC prides itself justifiably by the quality of their pieces. Most replicas fall quite far from this goal, being built with poor quality materials, or in most cases substandard dials and date wheels.

Most IWC replicas are based on a variety of Asian movements, but recently several replicas based on ETA movements have come onto the market. These range from IWC Portuguese and Big Pilots to some of the newer chronographs.
